●**Sun. May 14**—Divine Liturgy at 10 a.m.

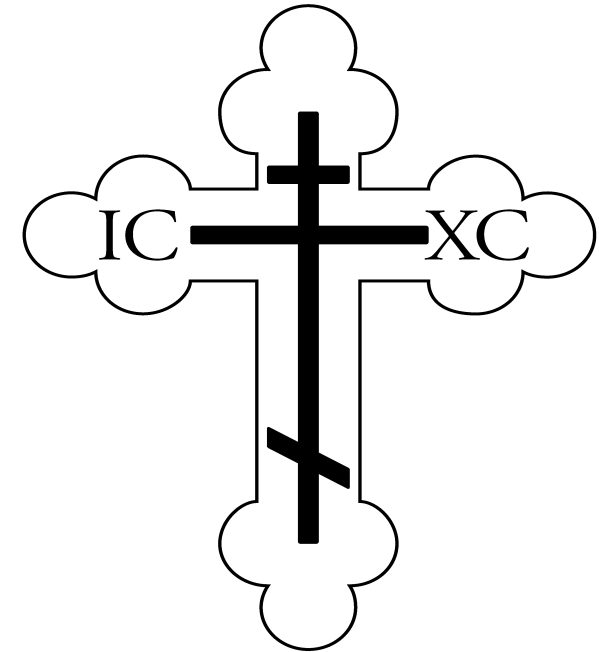
