On July 15-16, 2017, there will be a glorification of a new Serbian saint in America—St. Mardarije (Madarius) of Libertyville. When they opened his tomb for the first time, his body was found to be incorrupt (like St. John of Shanghai and San Francisco) and exuding a sweet, fragrant smell.

It should be known that St. Mardaije was the one who consecrated our very own St. George Church in Duluth in 1923. We even have the picture of him, with all our parishioners around him, on the front steps of our church. Not every church can boast that a saint consecrated their church and was there at its opening.

Sts. Constantine and Helen’s Day & Memorial Saturday—June 3rd

On Pentecost we commemorate the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles in the form of tongues of fire. This holiday is traditionally known as the birthday of the Church and is one of the twelve great feastdays. For the three days of Pentecost, we will have three consecutive Divine Liturgies: Sunday, June 4th to Tuesday, June 6th. All Liturgies will be at 10 a.m. (with Great Vespers on Sat. June 3rd, at 5 p.m.)

Building Repair Project

The church temple and hall are in need of repair. There has been leakage around the edges of the roof and cupola of the church.

Early last fall technicians caulked these suspected areas and some of the leaking has been stopped. This is something that needs to be done every year. There is also mortar coming loose from between the bricks of the church and the hall which are showing signs of aging. This spring, summer and fall we plan to address as many of these problems as possible. A budget of \$55,000 was set at the annual meeting. We are hoping to raise at this time as much funding as possible for this project.

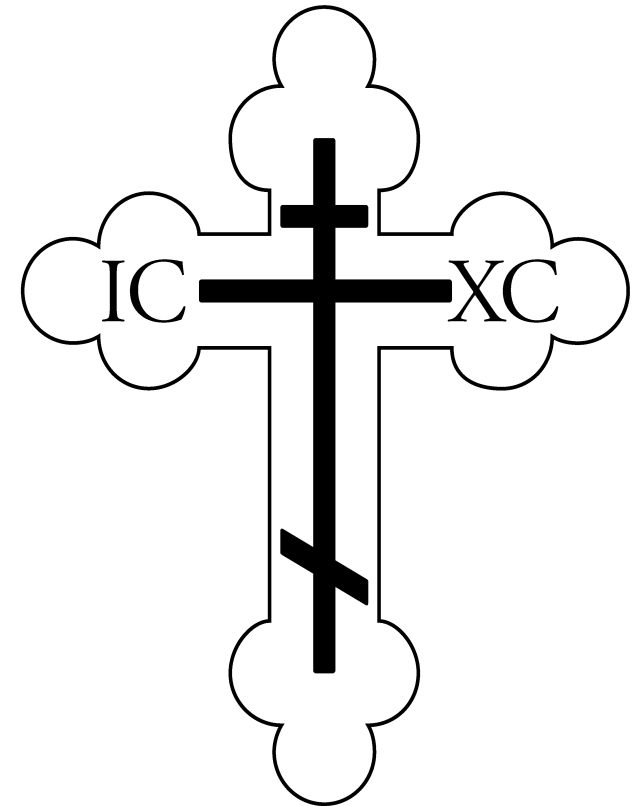
