Wednesday, May 24th is Sts. Cyril and Methodius' Day—a red letter feastday. We will have Great Vespers on the eve of the feast, Tuesday, at 5 p.m., with Divine Liturgy on Wednesday at 10 a.m.

About Sts. Cyril and Methodius

According to St. Nikolai Velimirovich's Prologue of Ohrid (Lives of Saints), they "were brothers from Thessalonica of distinguished and wealthy parents... The older brother Methodius spent ten years as an officer among the Macedonian Slavs and thus learned the Slavic language. After that Methodius withdrew to Mount Olympus and dedicated himself to the monastic life... It was here that Cyril (Constantine) later joined him..."

After great missionary activity and baptizing many Slavic peoples, "they returned to Constantinople where they compiled the Slavonic alphabet consisting of thirty-eight letters and proceeded to translate ecclesiastical books from Greek into Slavonic."

It was through their missionary efforts that our Slavic ancestors came to accept the true Christian faith and worship God in a language that they could understand, thus passing their love of Orthodoxy onto future generations.

Ascension—May 25th

On Thursday, May 25th, we will celebrate the Ascension of our Lord—one of the twelve great feasts of our Church. We will have Great Vespers on the eve of the feast, Wednesday, at 5 p.m., with Divine Liturgy at 10 a.m. on Thursday.

Forty days after His rising from the dead, our Lord Jesus Christ appeared to His disciples telling them to preach, starting from Jerusalem, the good news of His Resurrection, the need for repentance for all, the forgiveness of

sins and baptism in the name of the Holy Trinity. He also told them to stay in Jerusalem until they were clothed with power by the Holy Spirit Who would soon be sent. Then our Lord, from the Mount of Olives, ascended off the ground before His disciples' eyes into heaven to sit, with His body, at the right hand of God the Father for all eternity.


